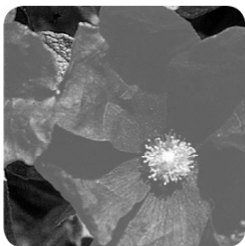

The vegetables should be displayed within an area of 18 x 24 in (45 x 60cm) without bending any part of them. The tray, board or staging must not be cut or mutilated in any way at all. No part of an exhibit should exceed the size of the tray. Parsley garnish and a black base cloth are allowed but no other foliage or accessories. Onion tops may be tied or whipped using raffia or string. Each type of vegetable carries a maximum of 20 points.
